



Mile High Wakeboarding™ Milliken Swimming Pool Rules

MHW Use Only - Print Name(s)

- All swimmers and pool patrons participate and swim of their own free will and do so at their own risk. There is no lifeguard on duty.
- No one is allowed in pool unless pool is officially open. Violators can be subject to fines and/or criminal charges.
- Regardless of skill level, all pool participants must sign the proper liability forms prior to participating in any pool activity. Swimmers under the age of 18 must also have a parent or legal guardian sign their liability forms and these pool rules prior to using the pool.
- Children must never be left unattended. All children under the age of thirteen (13) years old entering the pool complex must be accompanied and cared for at poolside by a supervising adult 18 years old or older, in bathing suit attire. Due to the high risk nature of the activity, children under seven (7) years old need to have a supervising adult in the water with them and within arms reach at all times. Use of the wading pool is restricted to children five (5) years old and under, and each child must be supervised at all times by a supervising adult at least 18 years old or older.
- All patrons of the pool are required to pay the facility admission fee; see pricing. On each visit, patrons must check-in with the office/cashier to receive a daily wrist band identifying that they have paid admission. ID may be required. Patrons should be ready to show serial numbered wrist band to appropriate MHW personnel upon request or upon re-entering pool facility.
- The rules and requests made by MHW staff should always be followed.
- Small children may swim in the pool only if they are potty-trained or wearing waterproof diapers/swim pants.
- Acceptable and non-offensive swim attire must be worn by patrons on the deck and in the water.
- All patrons must shower with soap before entering the pool, and wash feet if entering the facility barefooted. The use of sunscreen is encouraged, however patrons should shower before re-entering the water after applying sunscreen.
- No sprayable sunscreens or oils of any kind are permitted. Lotion-based sunscreens and tanning products are acceptable.
- Persons with open cuts, sores, bandages, colds, coughs, or infected eyes are not permitted in the pool.
- Walk; don't run while in and around the pool facility. No more than 2 large steps before entering the pool (no running and jumping into the pool).
- Water toys, noodles, and floats are permitted (wings are not) if it is a non-crowded day, and the toy/float does not bother other patrons. All subject to pool managers discretion.
- All slide users must be thirteen (13) years old. Ensure the coast is clear before using the slide, and stay clear of slide landing zones after sliding. Only one person at a time on a slide or ladder. Parents may not ride with children. Floats, wings, noodles, and water toys are not allowed while using a slide.
- Keep deck furniture, towels, and strollers at least 5 feet from the edge of swimming pool.
- Music, MP3s, iPods, and small radios are allowed as long as the music is PG rated, not loud, and does not offend other patrons and participants.
- Unsafe or disruptive behavior, profanity, or fighting may result in a loss of privileges with no refund; authorities may also be involved, and charges may be filed. Running, boisterous or rough play, pushing, acrobatics, dunking, wrestling, splashing, yelling, diving or jumping haphazardly, snapping of towels, improper conduct causing undue disturbances on or about the pool area, or any acts which would endanger any patron are prohibited.
- No prolonged underwater swimming contests for time or distance, and no extensive breath holding.
- All patrons and participants are responsible for their own conduct, including damage or destruction of property to others.
- All swimming pool patrons must be free from the influence of drugs or alcohol at all times. Persons who appear to be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics will be denied admission.
- All bags and backpacks are subject to search.
- Pets are not permitted in the pool area, with the exception of guide dogs. Guide dogs may be on the deck as long as acceptable shade and fresh drinking water are available and provided.
- Water-borne pathogens can be present in any body of water. Do not drink or allow your pet to drink swimming pool or lake water.
- Spitting, spouting, or nose-blowing, urinating, or defecating in the pool is strictly prohibited. Any child/person experiencing even a mild case of diarrhea may not use any pool.
- Secure all of your personal belongings. MHW is not responsible for any lost or stolen property. Lockers are available for rent.
- Single groups shall not monopolize a particular area of the pool and thereby limit its use by or intimidate other patrons. Only MHW scheduled classes, staff/team activities, or rental groups are permitted. Private group uses are not permitted during a recreation swim period and must be scheduled as a private rental.
- A portion of the pool complex may be reserved from time to time for private parties and/or events. (The gated areas.)
- No coolers, food, gum, glass, or tobacco products are allowed inside the pool complex. No smoking is allowed ever, anywhere in the pool complex or on property.
- MHW may need to close the swimming pool facility from time to time due to health, safety, inclement weather, lighting, mechanical failure, repair, or at the discretion of the manger. No refunds are given for any reason. Credit/raincheck for a return visit is allowed in the event of a mechanical failure and on a case by case basis.
- Emergency procedures must be observed. Swimmers must leave the pool area immediately upon a signal (whistle) or request of MHW staff.
- Emergency life rings and life saving equipment are on site, in plain view. Any emergency or injury must be reported to MHW staff immediately.
- The use of cameras, video cameras, or any device containing camera equipment of any kind is prohibited in all locker rooms, bathrooms, and changing facilities.
- All swimming pool patrons must obey these safety rules and guidelines at all times. Rules and guidelines are subject to change without notice and are subject to pool managers discretion.
- A patron will be verbally warned for the first offense; the patron will be asked to leave the pool facility if a second offense occurs.
- MHW reserves the right to revoke privileges or refuse service to anyone, for any reason whatsoever, with or without cause.
- Use common sense, be considerate, and respect the rights and feelings of others patrons and participants.
